The original full sized globe like this miniature was made in Paris in 1745. As you can see the Alaskan Territory was yet uncharted. Our idea was to make a fun novelty clock using a turning globe. To read the time, find your location on the globe then follow the longitude line down to the time ring at the equator. There is your time, white numbers for AM, black for PM. This will also give you time relative to the rest of the world, but remember not all of the rest of the world observes daylight savings time. A note of caution. The globe can not be turned by hand, as manual rotation can damage the movement. To set the time, the globe can be lifted to disengage with the smaller gear below the globe, then lowered to re-mesh at a closer time, then use the set knob on the movement under the base to fine adjust for the time. This is driven by a AA battery and needs changing once a year. If replacing the unit be sure to use a standard high torque battery movement.
